


Marta was a very happy little girl, always laughing and playing non-stop.

Several days went by like this, Marta would pee in the toilet and, at night, when her mom put her diaper on, she would poop.




Marta cried and was very nervous because she wanted to go and play.


After a few days, Marta stopped going to the toilet.
